Class Definitions: Covering Horse / Pony / Donkey

Novice: Horse, Pony or Driver who has not won a similar class at a show.

Two or Four Wheeled hard tyred Turnout - Traditional

Style: any two or four-wheeled vehicle with solid rubber or iron tyres (not pneumatic) of a Traditional style rather than purpose built for CDEs, but excluding Trade or Delivery vehicles.

Trade/Delivery Turnout: horse or pony, vehicle, harness, dress and accessories to be in traditional commercial style.

Conditions of Entry for Harness Classes:

1. Horse and Pony references also includes **Donkeys**.
2. **Donkeys are permitted at this show** and may compete in height relevant & applicable vehicle and other classes.
3. Cruelty to, or abuse of any animal will result in the offender being withdrawn from any further classes.
4. An exhibitor showing an animal which does not appear to be sound or shows evidence of lameness, exhaustion or distress, may be asked to withdraw it immediately from further competition. This may include horses or ponies which appear to be distressed or exhausted due to the weight of the turnout being pulled. Recommended ratio horse: weight being pulled is 1:1.
5. The organisers reserve the right to request the withdrawal of any horse, pony or turnout which appears unsafe.
6. **All harness horses and ponies must be shown in winkers**
7. Bitless bridles, running or standing martingales, side reins, trotting type overchecks, running reins, boots or bandages are **not permitted** on horses or ponies whilst competing.

8. Competitors shall at all times compete at their own risk. Maffra Agricultural Society show committee take no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to competitors, animals, equipment or vehicles.
9. The organisers reserve the right to alter the program according to conditions on the day. If the show is cancelled due to weather conditions, entry fees will not be returned.
10. Whilst the organisers will endeavour to accommodate all competitors, classes may not be delayed due to clashes between rings. Classes may be combined or split depending on entries and also at the judge's discretion.
11. Horses will be allocated areas and must not be driven, ridden or tethered amongst spectators.
12. **No electric fencing permitted.**
13. DOGS must be tied up inside floats / trucks or on a leash at all times. Dogs are NOT permitted on carriage vehicles.
14. All EVPHC members competing at this show will be placed on the duty roster.
